Business Meeting

Len Parsons, Vice President of Silver Jackets, called the meeting to order and welcomed the members and reminded them that USG / Tech Benefits has scheduled a meeting to provide information about upcoming changes in the Board of Regents Health Plan for Medicare-eligible Retirees:

Friday, May 8 at 11:00 AM in the Student Center Auditorium. This presentation will be by **Aon Retiree Health Exchange**, the private exchange through which Board of Regents Health Plan is offering Medicare-eligible retirees a defined contribution, which can be used to purchase private supplemental Medicare coverage.

Vice President Parsons introduced **Jasmine Burton**, a recent Georgia Tech graduate. Her three-person team won Tech's 2014 InVenture Prize Competition. She is Founder & President of her company **Wish for WASH**.

Ms. Burton explained that **Wish for WASH, LLC** is a social impact organization designed to bring innovation to sanitation.

Topics discussed by Ms. Burton included the following:

Review of immense need for sanitation facilities particularly in view of the massive numbers of refugees in today's world;

Existing products on the market;

Historical steps in the development of the new product;

Key factors in design of the product: odor control, user experience, cutting cost to \$40.
