Program

John Balsam introduced our speaker, Leanne West, Chief Engineer of Pediatric Technologies and Chief Innovation Officer, with the Georgia Tech Pediatric Technology Center (PTC). She spoke to us about the relationship of PTC with the Children's Healthcare of Atlanta (CHOA). Ms. West matches funding from seed grants, extramural and secondary funding to facilitate collaboration between clinicians, doctors, and researchers across campus conducting research to advance children's health and pediatric services. She told us about a some specific quick win projects that have been conducted, such as the cap sleeve to lessen infection, and the pressure ulcer prevention system to prevent ulcers in infants. We heard about the MRI training device that allows children to become accustomed to the MRI prior to the actual experience. We learned of endowments and other sources of funding provided for PTC projects, as well as outreach that go beyond CHOA to a number of other children's health organizations.
