## Program 1997

The program was presented by **Debbie Ivie, an urban wildlife rehabilitator**. Debbie's designation is licensed and regulated by the Department of Natural Resources. She gave an overview of how the program operates, explaining that rehabilitators may deal with all animals or specialize in certain animals.

Debbie gave several tips on how to deal with wildlife that you find in your yard:

- If you find a baby animal, try to reunite it with its family. A baby bird can be put back in the nest, and the mother will continue to care for it.
- If you can't reunite, call a rehabilitator for help. Rehabilitators are trained to take care of animals that are too small to make it on their own or are injured. The goal is to be able to eventually release the animal back into the wild.
- Take down birdfeeders in August, so that the birds will migrate.
- Don't feed raccoons on your deck. That will encourage them to go on your neighbor's deck, where they may not be welcomed.
